10. What Did Daniel Say? Daniel 12:1

What Jesus Says? Matthew 24:11-13

"Then many false prophets will rise up and deceive many. And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold.

But he who endures to the end shall be saved."

Matthew 24:21-22

"For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be.

And unless those days were shortened, no flesh would be saved; but for the elect's sake those days will be shortened."

Matthew 24:29-30

Therefore, be zealous and repent."

To him who overcomes I will grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne."

What Jesus Says? Revelation 12:11

- When the going gets rough and tough, He will most certainly pull us through!





What Jesus says:

John 15:18-20

"If the world hates you, you know that it hated Me before it hated you. If you were of the world, the world would love its own. Yet because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you. Remember the word that I said to you, 'A servant is not greater than his master.' If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you. If they kept My word, they will keep yours also. But all these things they will do to you for My name's sake, because they do not know Him who sent Me."

What Jesus says:

Matthew 13:21; Mark 4:17

"Yet hath he not root in himself, but dureth for a while: for when tribulation or persecution ariseth because of the word, by and by he is offended." [KJV]

"yet he has no root in himself but endures only for a while. For when tribulation or persecution arises because of the word, immediately he stumbles." [NKJV]

 Top priority is watering (nurturing) our roots (our relationship) with our Lord Jesus during our Quiet Time!

What Jesus says:

Matthew 10:28; Luke 12:4-5

"And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell."

"And I say to you, My friends, do not be afraid of those who kill the body, and after that have no more that they can do. But I will show you whom you should fear: Fear Him who, after He has killed, has power to cast into hell; yes, I say to you, fear Him!"

What Jesus says: John 16:33

"These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace.

In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."

RECAP: What Jesus Says:

- "Immediately after the tribulation of those days ... Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, ..., and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. And He will send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they will gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other." [Matthew 24:29-31]
- Lord Jesus makes no mention of a Pre-Tribulation or Mid-Tribulation Rapture!

RECAP: What Jesus Says:

- Instead, Jesus clearly states, "If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you" [John 15:19]
- "Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and kill you, and you will be hated by all nations for My name's sake." [Matthew 24:9]
- "And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell." [Matthew 10:28]
